CLASS DESCRIPTIONS BY AGE:

Dance Together (Age 2-3): This class offers our youngest students and their guardian an introduction to music and movement.

Creative Dance (Age 3-4): This class offers our younger students an introduction to music and movement. Props and music are used to stimulate and nurture the imagination. Our aim is to instill a love for dance movement! Students must be potty-independent.

Combo (Ballet & Tap) (Age 5-7): Each one-hour session incorporates instruction in both Ballet and Tap. Children learn the basics of rhythm, coordination, grace & posture.

Acro Intermediate (Age 9-18): Previous experience required. Acro-Dance combines classical dance with acrobatic elements.

Intro to Ballet (Age 9-18): This class is designed for students who are interested in getting a taste of basic ballet technique, including barre, center and across-the-floor work.

Adult Ballet: Previous Ballet Experience required.

Adult Pilates: Mat-based class that focuses on strength, stability, posture, proper breath control and flexibility.
